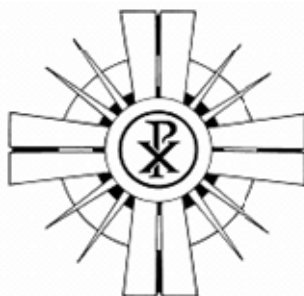

* * The parish "tithed" 5 % of this Offertory to the dual collection for Native American missions and the work of the Catholic Church among people of color here in the USA. We added \$ 180 to the generous gifts of \$ 350 you provided, bringing the second collection total to \$ 530 and reducing the Offertory to \$ 3,405. Attendance was 100 below average and only 20 worshipers more than 2016's low point. The Offertory, however, was virtually tied with 2012 for the second place out of six years. Typical of early June in Wurtsboro, the weather flip-flopped, gorgeous on Saturday; blah on Sunday.
