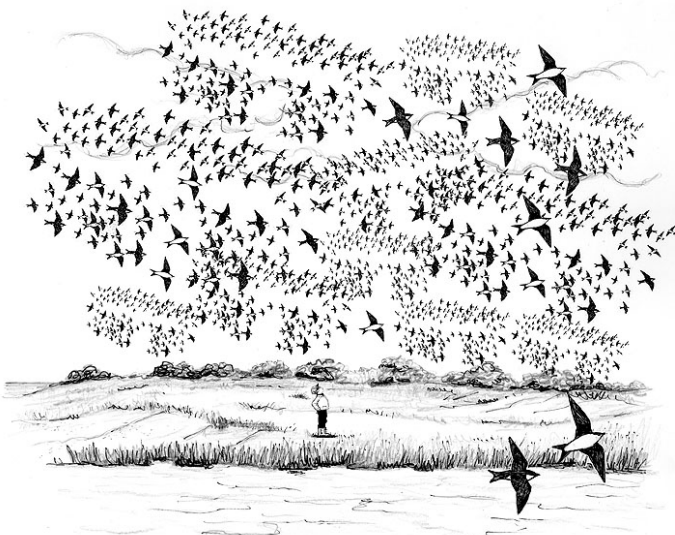

This weekend, we return to the Sundays of "Ordinary Time" with semi-continuous readings. We will pick up with *Jeremiah 20: 10 to 13; Romans 5: 12 to 15; and Matthew 10: 26 to 33.* Next weekend, on the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time," we will read from *II Kings 4: 8 to 16; Romans 6: 3 to 11; and Matthew 10: 37 to 42.*

SPECIAL COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND

If you detect a pattern to these special collections, you're right!

The American bishops, confronted with the great needs of the Church and her people, at home and abroad, has set aside twelve special collections. With a few exceptions, they fall on the first Sundays of their respective months.

Next weekend's collection is called "Solidarity with Africa." It is aptly named

because the Church in Africa is growing more rapidly than in any other place in the world. Africans no longer need missionaries in great numbers; their native clergy and religious vocations far outnumber those of North America. Nevertheless, the challenges there are great. Inter-tribal warfare, the sinister power of ISIS, rampant disease, human trafficking, poverty and hunger all challenge the African continent and tax the resources of the Catholic Church. Where there is a strong Catholic presence, we express our solidarity by supporting their efforts. Where the faith is still in its infancy, or threatened by persecution, we channel our help through welfare agencies and our own remaining missionary outposts. This is why your donation is important and will be added to the parish's 5% "tithe" of next weekend's Offertory.

We had the worst attendance *EVER* for Fathers' Day weekend, 70 fewer worshipers than average, 60 fewer than the median and 190 fewer than our last high point in 2012. Figures for the early teens of this century, remember, are themselves significantly lower than those of the first decade. The Offertory, wonderful to tell, tied for second place both with 2013 and 2016. The Hx3 weather was unusual for Fathers' Day weekend.
