Attendance dropped like a stone -- from an average of 335, and a one-time high of 360, and even last year's 330, to an abysmal 270. There's little point in speaking about it at Mass -- that's "preaching to the choir," as they say. It should be obvious, however, that continued poor attendance is a problem for any parish. The Offertory Collection has fluctuated on the weekend after Easter between highs of over \$ 3,500 and lows of a thousand dollars less. Last week's was the second lowest of six years. We hope that milder weather will bring a thaw in our figures as well.
