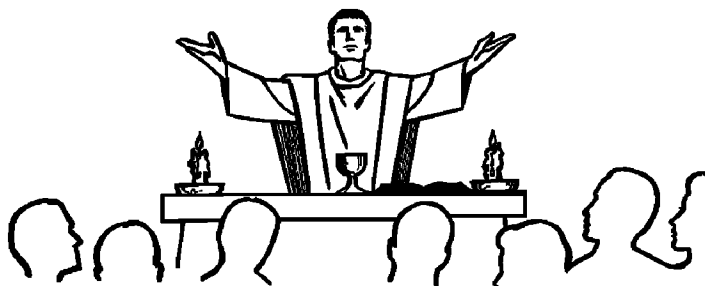

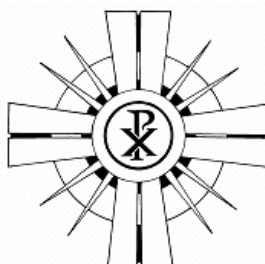
NEXT SUNDAY'S SCRIPTURES

TO THANK GOD . . .



When's the last time you spoke with Our Father about your life -- its value, sacredness, beauty? When's the last time you were aware of God's generous presence with you -- in, and through, other people? Mass is called the "eucharist" from a Greek word meaning, "great thanksgiving." It translates the Hebrew, "berekah," a blessing -- akin to "Grace Before Meals." The words Jesus spoke over the bread and the wine began, "We give thanks to the Lord, our God." Since these words were meant to interpret the meaning of His death, that act of self-effacing love for His Father becomes the one and only "berekah" the world will ever need. Join us for 9 AM Mass on Thursday and add your thanks to the Great Eucharist of Christ.
